"The mother bird sat on her eggs at the water's edge, and when I approached she pushed off with her foot as though the nest had been a boat, and away she floated calmly down the stream." "What you saw was a rare spectacle," said the nature student. "The bird was a grebe, the columbus minor. She always builds on the water's edge, and her nest is always woven of aquatic plants so closely and firmly that it will float herself and her eggs without leaking." "On the approach of danger the bird pushes off. Nor is she at the current's mercy during her voyage. She uses her foot as a paddle, and I have seen her steer her boat nest with some little dexterity around a bend, landing in a quiet cove as well, say, as the average young lady waterman."
