WEATHER REPORT
The steamship President, 150 miles south of North Head last night, reported the barometer 30.14, with a light southerly breeze and a smooth sea. A weak high pressure area over the northern states from the Pacific coast east to the Great Lakes. The pressure is relatively low over Oregon and Saskatchewan. The disturbance yesterday over the lake region is now central over northern New England. No rain has fallen west of the Rocky mountains during the 12 hours ending with this report. Light to moderately heavy showers are reported over a strip of territory extending from the Rocky mountains to the New England states. The changes in temperature since yesterday have been important.
