

How to Answer Advertisements Addressed to Box Numbers, Care of the Journal

Many persons do not know how to answer advertisements addressed to newspaper offices, and for the convenience of those we wish to say that if they wish to get in touch with such advertisers, they should send a letter addressed to the box number, in care of The Journal office.

A personal call is not wanted by the advertiser and the only way to get in communication with this kind of an advertiser is to address your letter with a box number just as though the advertisement carried the original name.

Bring or send the letter to The Journal office (when brought direct to the office the letter does not require a stamp). When sent through the mails the letter is treated as ordinary correspondence.

The letter upon reaching The Journal office is stamped the date received and deposited in a box set aside for that purpose—the party who inserted the advertisement calls for the replies and does business with the answers that seem the most suited to his or her needs.
