Former Auditor Gets \$45,000 Worth of Municipal Improvement Bonds.

REMAINDER OF ISSUE BRINGS GOOD PREMIUM

Ways and Means Committee Highly Pleased Over Results of Persistent Advertising—One Per Cent or Better on Entire Allotment.

After advertising four times for the sale of \$183,677.95 worth of municipal improvement bonds, the ways and means committee yesterday disposed of the remaining \$103,677.95, getting a premium of 1 per cent or better. Last week \$80,000 worth of the bonds brought 1 per cent premium or better.
