SOUGHT BY LEAGUE

Chicago, Ill., Aug. 29.—Representatives of influential commercial organizations throughout the country wers on hand today at the opening of the conference called by the National Industrial league. The expressed purpose of the league, which was formed at a conference here three weeks ago, is to weld together and make more effective the efforts of the members toward what some of them term commercial freedom. The league will endeavor to bring about a better cooperation between the shippers, railroads and the federal and state railroad commissions in matters of mutual concern.

Perhaps the most important subject up for consideration at the present meeting is the ruling giving to the initial railroad the right to route the freight. The shippers believe that with the right to route their freight as they please they will be able to secure better strice from the roads, and they insat that it is that legal right.
