FARMERS HOPE AND FEAR WITH WEATHER (Special Dispatch to The Journal.)

Tekoa, Wash., Sept. 18. - Threshing has been greatly hampered by the continual damp weather. Nearly all grain has been cut except on the reservation, where there is still some grain too green to cut.

The spirits of the farmers and threshermen rise and fall according to the weather. A few days of rain makes them gloomy, and then "great damage has been done." But the sun peeps out bright and warm for a day or two, the machines begin to hum again, and the demage seems very moderate.

It is hard to get a reliable report, but so far as can be learned the damage to wheat is really small. Some oats are colored and some hay has been spoiled. Reports of big yields continue to come in, the largest being 52 bushels per acre on 40 acres on the farm of William Hoy, six miles south of here. Threshermen say wheat will average 40 bushels per acre through this section.
