

DEVLIN'S REPORT SHOWS ASSETS OF \$2,209,536

Know Liabilities Exceed Assets Over Hundred Thousand—Lease of Property at Sixth and Washington Is Not Included in Summary of Savings Bank.

The report of Thomas C. Devlin, receiver of the defunct Oregon Trust & Savings bank, was filed late yesterday afternoon. The total assets shown, not including the lease of the bank building, amount to \$2,209,536.11. The known liabilities are \$2,328,668. The statement of assets does not include the property turned over to the receiver by Mr. Moore, the former president of the bank. On the other hand it does include the bank's claim against the Golden Eagle store, amounting in round numbers to over \$100,000. The store is in the hands of an assignee.
