INSANE WOMAN TRICKED BY DUMMY CHILD DIES TRYING TO SAVE TOY.

(Journal Special Service.) London, Sept. 30.—A pitiful tragedy has ended in Paris with the death of Madame Magdoux, a mad woman, who a year ago lost her infant son through illness.

After her bereavement she lay for some months between life and death. She had lost her strength, she wandered continually through the house calling for her child. A doctor pronounced her insane and suggested to her husband that he should place a doll in the empty cradle in the hope that the woman would devote her affection to it.

A large wax doll was bought, clothed in the dead child's garments and placed in the cradle. The bereaved mother found it believed to be her lost son, and was passionately devoted to it. She took it out for an airing every day, dressed it and undressed it, and would hold it in her arms for hours together.

Usually her husband accompanied her when she took the doll out, but on Monday he was unable to return home at the usual time and Madame Magdoux, wheeling a perambulator with the doll in it, crossed the street and crossed the square Parmentier, a van collided with the perambulator, which was upset.

The doll fell out and was crushed by the wheels of the van. The woman gave a cry of shrill despair and flung herself to the ground in an effort to recover her breast and she died without recovering consciousness.
