WEATHER REPORT

The pressure is rising over the northern California coast and falling over British Columbia. Cloudy skies prevail in consequence over western Oregon and western Washington. The depression over the southwest is developing and this morning overpicks the entire middle and southern plateau regions. It is lacking in energy, though cloudiness is increasing over the territory under its influence. The immense high area overlying the central portion of the country is extending its influence eastward. It still retains its pronounced character, and the morning clear and cold weather prevails over the Missouri and Mississippi valleys, with heavy frosts. Temperatures over the Dakotas ranged considerably below the freezing point. The disturbance over the upper lakes yesterday has drifted eastward. It has assumed a more typical character, general rains having fallen over the middle Atlantic and New England states during the last 24 hours. Cloudy weather with increasing rain is indicated over northwestern and eastern Oregon and southern Idaho tonight and Sunday. It has assumed a more typical character with possibly rain is indicated for Sunday.
