

ALTON LOSES BY TWO-CENT FARE

Road Says It Is Deprived of \$150,000 in Four Months by New Law.

(United Press Leased Wire.) Chicago, Nov. 5.—During the last four months the Alton road has lost approximately \$150,000 by reason of the operation of the two-cent passenger law in the state of Illinois and Missouri. General Passenger Agent Charlton of the Alton, which has only 900 million of passenger traffic, says the statistics of short-line receipts of passenger tickets since the law went into effect, and has made a careful comparison of the receipts during the corresponding months of former years. In some of the larger cities the sale of tickets increased by as high as 5,000, whereas the receipts from the sales decreased as much as \$5,000. Everywhere it was shown that the sales of tickets had increased amazingly.

GRAYS HARBOR COUNTY?—NAY

Washington Supreme Court Tells Why It Cannot Be; Not Yet.

(Special Dispatch to The Journal.) Olympia, Wash., Nov. 5.—The proposed county of Grays Harbor has been knocked out by the state supreme court in a divided opinion. The act creating the proposed new county is declared to be "indefinite and uncertain" and is therefore unconstitutional. The opinion is by Justice Root, and is concurred in by Chief Justice Hadley, and Justices Dunbar, Crow and Kudkin. Justice Mount filed a dissenting opinion, which is concurred in by Justice Fullerton. The constitution declares that no new county shall be created with a population of less than 2,000 or shall the county from which it is taken be left with less than 4,000 population. The act creating the new county provides that the question of population shall be ascertained by a judge of the superior court "in the nearest judicial district to the county of Chehalis," etc. The supreme court holds that in this provision the legislature has attempted to delegate power which it should exercise itself. The legislature, says the court, is required to know that it is meeting the requirements regarding population.
