WEATHER REPORT
As a result of a slight fall in barometer over western Washington and a small rise over northern California, gradients for southerly winds have occurred and light rain has fallen in the lower Columbia valley from Portland to the sea. The northwestern low pressure area has developed into a storm of considerable intensity which is central this morning north of Lake Huron. The western high pressure area now over the western Gulf states and a new high pressure area has formed in the Canadian northwest. Light snow is reported in the St. Lawrence valley. Light rain has fallen in the Atlantic and east Gulf states. Elsewhere generally fair weather prevails. It is much colder in South Carolina, Georgia and Florida, and decidedly warmer along the east slope of the northern Rocky mountains except in Canada, where it is colder.

The indications are for light rain Thursday west of the Cascade mountains and continued fair weather to the east of this range.
