Wall Street Journal Comments on the Combine Effected by Texas Growers.

OBJECT IS TO HOLD UP PRICE OF PRODUCT

Agriculturists Accused of the Same Form of Speculation Which Puts Unfavorable Comment on the Lamb Shearers.

Under the caption, "Whose Ox It Is," the Wall Street Journal of November 14 makes a labored effort to prove that the Texas cotton growers, who perfect an organization for the purpose of holding their crop for a higher price are equally guilty with the Wall street manipulator, who uses the banking machinery of the east for the purpose of controlling the sources of supply, and regulating output to obtain high prices for commodities.

It is surprising how few of the individual distinctions commonly presumed between methods in Wall street and methods in any other community.

Here is what the Wall street paper has to say:

It is alleged that big capitalists in Wall street sometimes use the banking machinery of the east for the purpose of controlling sources of supply and regulating output to obtain high prices for commodities.

There is probably no agriculturist who would hesitate to denounce such use of capital and credit in Wall street as morally wrong and injurious to the welfare of the whole people.

If this form of speculation be called conspiracy, then farmers are guilty of the like offense when they combine to regulate output and afterward employ the banking machinery of their sections to hold back their output and regulate the market supply.

A few days ago a delegation of Texas cotton planters appeared at the United States treasury asking for \$10,000,000 of government money with which to finance their undertakings in cotton, offering as security their warehouse receipts.

Millions of money to move crops, to facilitate commerce and to keep the markets going, and this rule should apply to Texas and Wall street equally.

Not a dollar for conspiracy against the free operation of the law of supply and demand. And this applies equally to stocks and cotton.
