learning, divided into two classes, colleges and schools.

The former clubs are to be composed of students in colleges and universities conferring degrees; the latter in public, preparatory, high and private schools and academies not conferring degrees. In either case not less than 20 members must belong to the club before it can be affiliated. These ciubs have the privilege, enjoyed by other clubs affiliated with the National Rifle association, of purchasing arms and ordnanes steres from the government at government prices.

The National Rifle association will give a prize to each club annually for competition among the members and later a code will probably be adopted with a suitable decoration for students qualifying under it.

Is connection with the work of interesting schoolboys in rifle practice it may be assumed that 60 or 70 per cent of any large body of volunteers would be under the age of 25 years. When young men get started on their business careers at 18 and 20 years of age it is hard for them to find time to practice with small arms and it is therefore regarded as highly desirable that the ground work should be laid before they start out in the world, trusting that their interest would then be maintained through later years. Much has been accomplished in this direction by the Public Schools Athletic league, of New York City, which has installed a number of
