

TEACH YOUNG IDEA TO SHOOT

School Boys in Rifle Practice Under National Rifle Association Tuition.

(Washington Bureau of The Journal) Washington, D. C., Nov. 29.—Gratifying progress is reported for the movement to interest school boys in rifle practice. At a recent meeting of the National Rifle Association directors the by-laws were amended so as to include among the affiliated organizations rifle clubs, organized institutions of learning, divided into two classes, colleges and schools.

The former clubs are to be composed of students in colleges and universities conferring degrees; the latter in public, preparatory, high and private schools and academies not conferring degrees. In either case not less than 20 members must belong to the club before it can be affiliated. These clubs have the privilege, enjoyed by other clubs affiliated with the National Rifle Association, of purchasing arms and ordinance stores from the government at government prices.

The National Rifle Association will give a prize to each club annually for competition among the members and later a code will probably be adopted with a suitable decoration for students qualifying under it.
