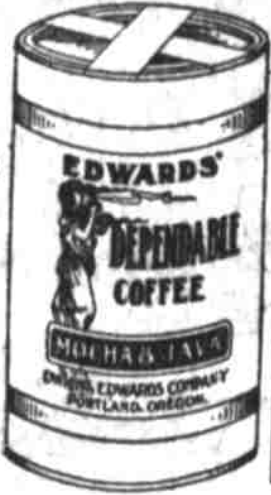


NEVER READ ABOUT STEUNENBERG CASE
