



PERFUMERY IN INDIA.

Roses Are Distilled in Northwest and Large Trade Is Carried on.

From Consular Report.

Scent distilling is carried on profitably in India, chiefly in the northwest, where roses, for instance, are largely grown to supply the distiller with what he wants. The chief perfumes used are rose water, lemon-grass oil, sandalwood oil, henna (Lawsonia alba), champa (Michelai champaca), maulsiri (Mimusops elengi), cajeput oil, harsongar (Nyctanthes arbor-tristis), keora or khetki (Pandanus odoratissimus), khas khas (Vatveria ziganicides and Andropogen squarrosus), motia er bela From Consular Report.

Men with a capital of perhaps \$106, or even less, distill these scents and sell them generally to others who conduct the retail trade. There thus comes out of the article two profits, that of the actual distillers and the retailers; in addition, the growers of the flowers, and sometimes agents who collect them, have also to make a profit out of the business. All of these men, of course, live in a very primitive way.
