Those who aren't from Harvard can go and see the play and probably enjoy it with an amused tolerance, as it isn't their own school that is being held up to the scorn of the audience...

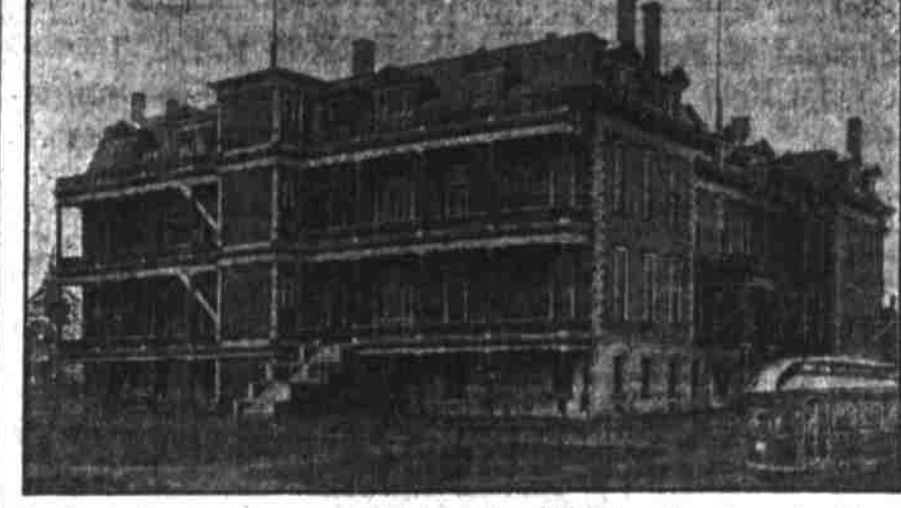
