

### CHINESE OUT OF EQUADOR

Merchants at Guayaquil Petition Government to Pass Rigid Exclusion Laws.  
(Special Dispatch to The Journal.) Guayaquil, Jan. 22.—The Telegraph Times, newspapers of Quito, publishers asking the government to prohibit the immigration of Chinese to Ecuador. The document declares that the Chinese are a pest to the country and are therefore able to work and produce for less than fair prices, so that the native merchants and workers have no chance at just competition. The Chinese acquire fortunes then leave the country for their own use with the money of the country, and in every sense they are undesirable citizens, doing nothing to protect institutions of the country, in which they have no interest, save for what they can get out of it. Political criminals, banished from Ecuador, have petitioned to be allowed return, but as yet the president has resolved the question. The petitioners expect a favorable answer and tranquility has been restored. At present the government has found it necessary to suspend the movement of Chinese carrying goods during the closed hours of the night here, and in the capital. There is not, however, at this time, a political prisoner in Ecuador. The steamer Itauri of the Kosmos line was fined for bringing its mail into port without the signature of the Ecuadorian consul at Valparaiso.

### OREGON HORSES FOR ALASKANS

White Pass-Dawson Stages Pulled by Steeds From This State.  
(Special Dispatch to The Journal.) White Pass, Alaska, Jan. 22.—A. W. Cottrell, superintendent of the White Pass-Dawson stage line in Alaska is now in eastern Oregon purchasing 75 head of horses suitable for that service. He says that his company has secured the most satisfactory stage horses in the past from eastern Oregon and that he will remain here until he purchases the number required. Cottrell's company operates a number of stage coaches in the north and west, making a relay of 35 miles. East-Oregon's hardy horses are especially well adapted to the work.

### MASS WORKERS ARE DISSOLVED BY COURT

(United Press Leased Wire.) Cleveland, Ohio, Jan. 22.—Judge Phillips of the common pleas court will today issue a formal order dissolving the Amalgamated Window Glass Workers' association. The court in its decision held that the union had violated the laws of the state. There are 6,000 members in the association. The court holds that the union is in violation of the law in its attempt to monopolize the glass business.

### RAIN HAS NARROW SCAPES FROM WRECKS

(United Press Leased Wire.) Berkeley, Cal., Jan. 22.—The north-bound train from San Francisco and Oroville passed through a narrow escape today, being wrecked with a number of cattle and horses. The coaches were nearly derailed. A fire started along the track near jumping the track.

### LONG EARTHQUAKE SHOCK FELT IN ITALY

(United Press Leased Wire.) Reggio, Di Calabria, Italy, Jan. 22.—A long earthquake shock was felt in the province today. The terrified population fled from their homes to the open air or took refuge in nearby subterranean grottoes. No loss of life has been reported.

### CALIFORNIA CHOSEN BY LIVESTOCK MEN

(United Press Leased Wire.) San Francisco, Cal., Jan. 22.—A telegram was received today at the office of the state board of trade from President Arthur H. Briggs of the board representing California at the annual convention of the American Livestock Raisers' Association in Denver, stating that by a vote of convention this morning the session of the association will be held in California, probably at Los Angeles, in 1908.

### FOR HORSEMANSHIP RETIRE OFFICERS

(United Press Leased Wire.) Washington, Jan. 22.—The retirement of army officers physically unable to perform the duties of their office was announced today. Among those retired was Captain Patrick J. Hart, who was attached to the coast army corps at the Presidio at San Francisco. The retirement was decided upon at a conference between the president and secretary of War Taft.
