WEATHER REPORT

A ridge of high pressure extends from Washington south to southern California, and the barometer is relatively high over the Mississippi valley. A severe storm is moving to sea down the St. Lawrence valley, and another disturbance of decided character is central northeast of Montana. Moderately heavy snow has fallen in the lake region and Ohio valley and rain is reported in the Atlantic states from Maine to Florida. Light snow has occurred at scattered places in Minnesota, North Dakota, southern Nevada, southern Utah and northern Arizona. The rains have ceased in northern California, but they continue in the southern part of that state. Fair weather has prevailed in the north Pacific states, with temperatures slightly below normal except in eastern Oregon and southwestern Idaho, where it is warmer than usual.
