RAILROADS GOBBLE ALL AVAILABLE TIMBER LAND

Records of Local Land Office Show That Wholesale Ravage of Oregon's Forests Has Been Consummated Through Operations of the Lieu Land Law.

So thoroughly have the forests of Oregon been gobbled up by the railroads of the state that at the present time according to figures compiled by the local land office there is very little unappropriated timber land left in the state. In the coast counties, which are particularly rich in timber and are comparatively untouched by the logger, the railroads have succeeded in corraling most of the valuable timber, the Southern Pacific having taken practically everything in sight through the workings of the act of July 1, 1892, allowing them to extend their original grant 10 miles each on each side of a right of way 10 miles further on each side.
