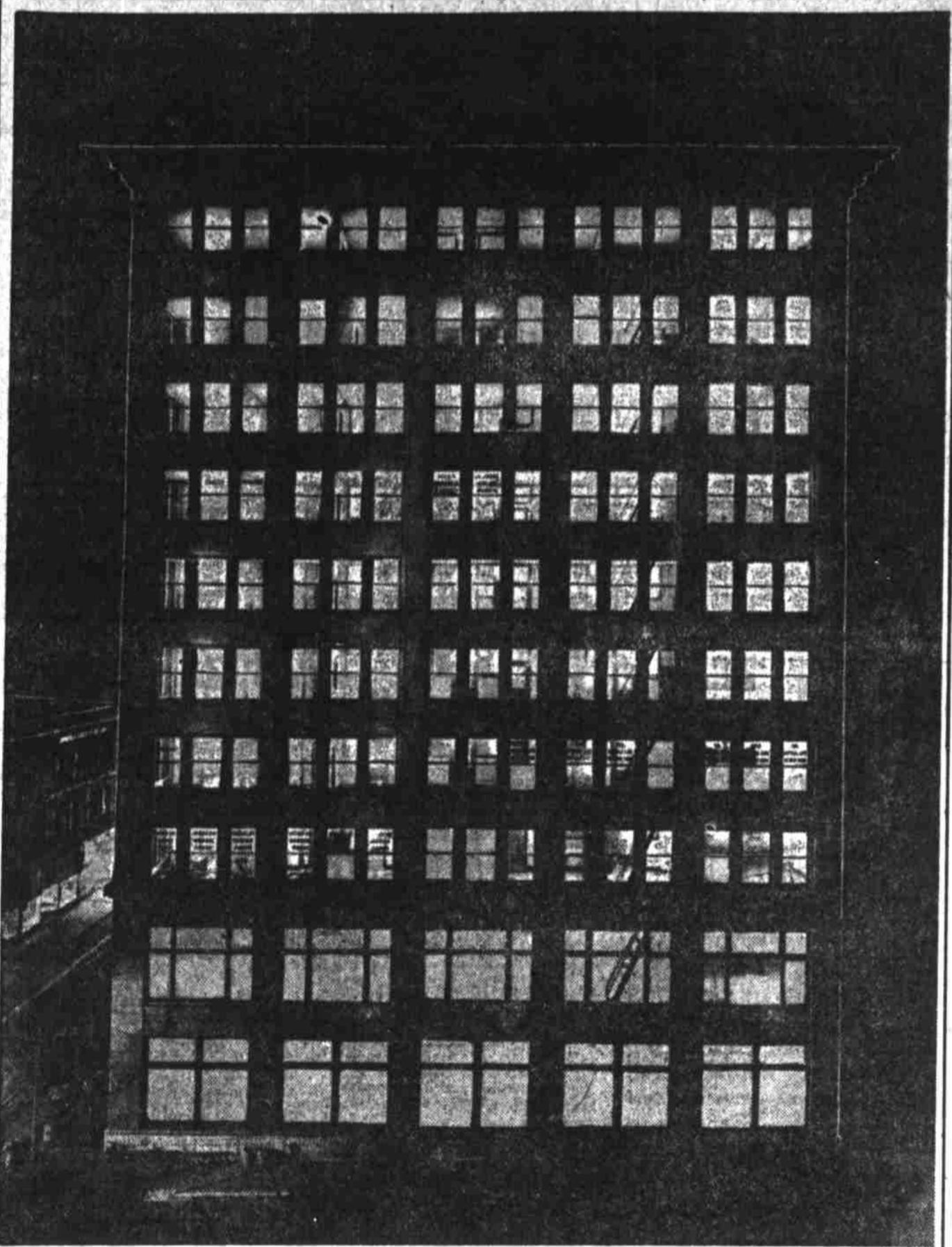


SKYSCRAPER IS RAPIDLY FILLING UP WITH TENANTS

This handsome office structure was thrown open for occupancy yesterday morning, and by night scores of offices were filled with tenants. Among the most important lease holders are the Security Savings & Trust company, H. Liebes & Co., J.
