

RESCUES SAILORS DYING IN WAVES

Oriental Liner Alesia Picks Up Men Clinging to the Overturned Schooner.

CARPENTER FALLS WITH FATAL RESULT

Popular Craft Returns From Hong-kong and Japanese Ports After Many Sensational Experiences—Brings Light Cargo.

The rescue at night of two shipwrecked sailors clinging to the keel of an overturned Japanese schooner was the feature of the Portland & Asiatic Steamship company's liner Alesia's voyage from Hongkong to Portland this time.

To the officers of the Nicomedia, the sailors gave their names as Uno Giam-buro and Mukai Isomatsu. In the 50 foot schooner they had started out from Meil from Hongkong on the 21st of January for its typhoon and treacherous squalls.

It was 8 o'clock on the evening of January 15, when chief officer Tamm sighted the overturned craft from the Alesia's bridge. Intermittently the boat was hidden from view in the trough of the sea, but with the aid of the marine glasses the officer finally made out two men clinging to the keel.

After leaving Kobe the Alesia proceeded to Yokohama, her last port of call before making her final start for the Columbia. From there she ran across the Pacific was made in 17 days. A heavy sea was running, but it was found in the same day that the steamer and hence did little damage.

The roster of the Alesia is about the same as on her last visit here, the deck officers being Captain Ernst, Chief Officer Tamm, Second Officer Mehus and Third Officer Aemke. The latter joined the steamer in Yokohama. The engineers are: first, Wack; second, Asporis; third, Loendorf; and fourth, Frederik.
