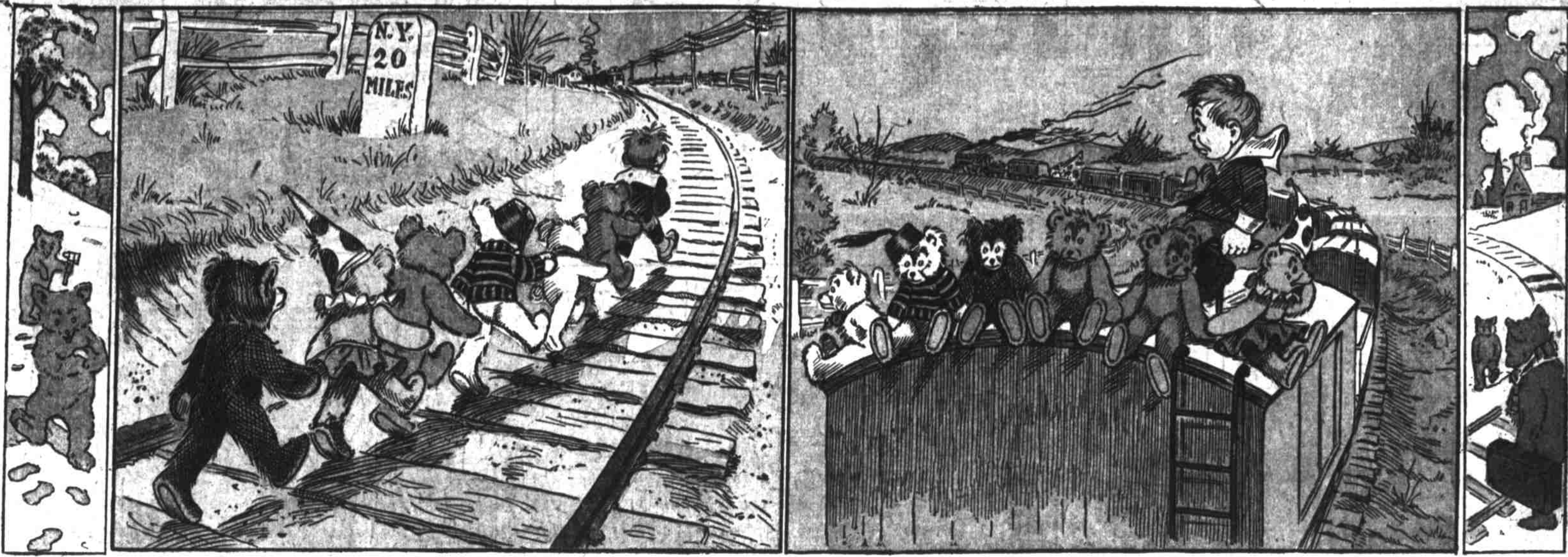
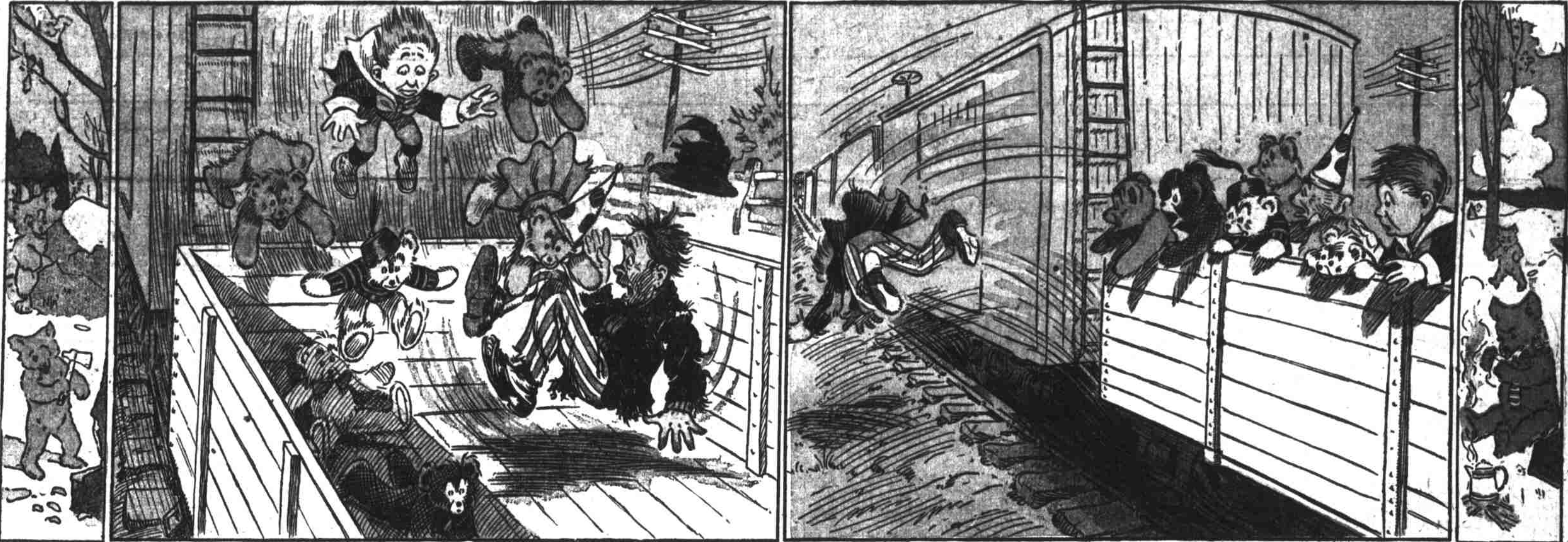

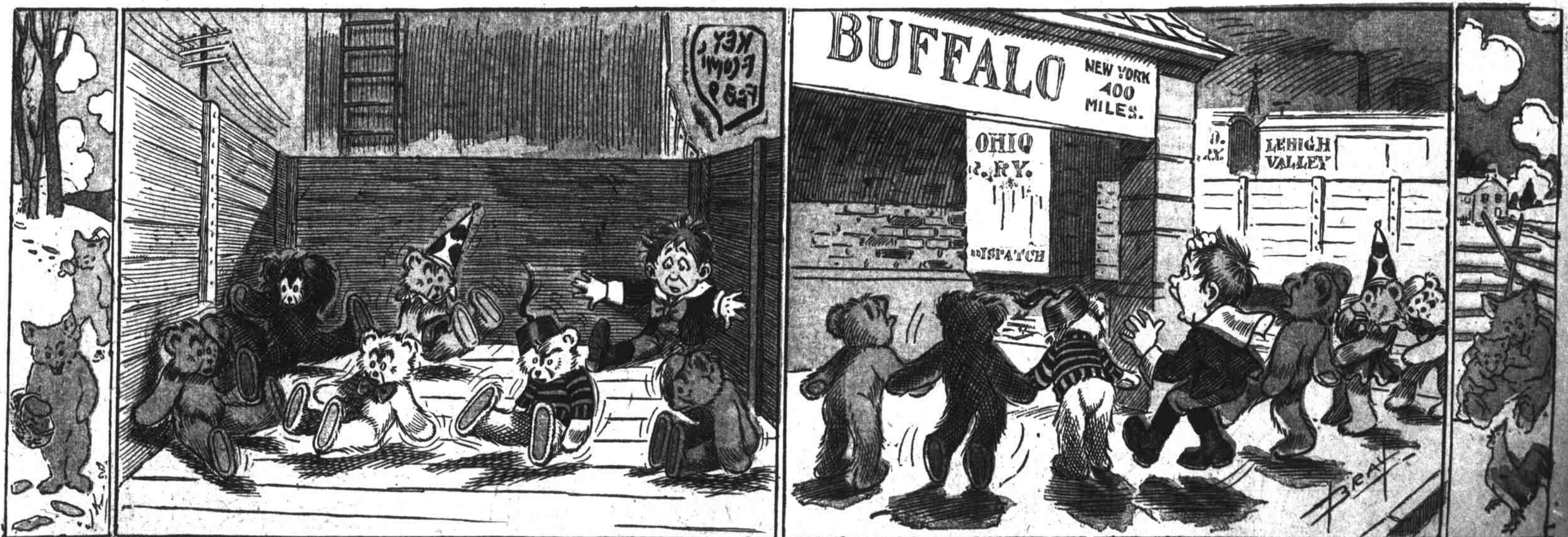
1. See John and Teds, a lonely crew.
