WORLD'S WHEAT CROP REPORT

Milder Weather Reported Throughout the Various Districts.  
While there was no damage to the wheat crop of the Pacific northwest during the past week, reports of freezing blizzards continue to come from the southwest, although that country has been covered with snow.

Broomhall gives the following report of the crops of the world in his Liverpool Corn Trade News:  
United Kingdom.  
The weather of the past week in the United Kingdom has been mild and generally dry enough to permit of plowing and sowing. The young standing wheat is looking all the better for the spell of pleasant weather with some sunbathing. The supply of English wheat varies at different markets, but in general has continued of good size, and prices have mostly continued to decline.

Argentina.  
Although the estimate for flaxseed has been reduced and corn has been damaged by drought, yet of wheat only favorable reports are heard, and estimates of crop and surplus are fully maintained. The shipping season is getting into full swing, and large quantities are confidently expected to be put afloat in the near future.

Tadla.  
Our Kurrachee correspondents write that they do not expect the rains to result in an increase of the area under wheat, but the yield from the crops already in the ground should be good, or even dry, however, and revivification of the rains have enabled further sowings to be undertaken. Shippers here still say they expect no surplus for export, and the latest official bulletin announced an increase of distress.

Australia.  
Last week's shipment of 1,400,000 bushels caused some surprise, but it can be confidently predicted that shipments of this size will be very few in 1906.

Russia.  
The weather has turned milder, but the snow cover in the interior is still there and it is a good one. The southwest is still bare of snow, and the heavy snow cover of the winter sowings, but latest southeastern reports are more hopeful. Odesa reports the receipt of surplus for export, and the latest official bulletin announced an increase of distress.

Buenos Aires.  
Our Bucharest correspondent telegraphs today that the weather is mild and crop conditions are unchanged. It is reported that Turkey is a good customer for Roumania wheat.

Hungary.  
An official bulletin dated January 15 reports that the acreage of winter wheat and rye is rather less than last year. The condition of the soil sowings gives cause for anxiety, but the early snow fields appear to be all right.
