

WHEAT BUSINESS IN PORTLAND EXPORTS REACH BIG TOTAL FOR MONTH OF FEBRUARY.

Wheat Exports Exceed Those of January, Which Themselves Were Formidable Enough to Command Attention.

Portland did a big export business during the month closing today, as will be seen by the figures printed above. The total value is about \$500,000 short of the record breaking total of the month of December of last year, but exceeds the grand total of January by about \$25,000.

Never before did Portland do such a tremendous export business as during the past three months, when approximately \$8,000,000 worth of native products of this district have been set afloat for ports across the sea.

OREGON LUMBER LOCATORS ENORMOUS SUM OF EASTERN AGENTS WHO SECURE APPLICANTS FOR RAILROAD GRANTS DRAWN TO COAST.

Enormous Sum of Eastern Agents Who Secure Applicants for Railroad Grants Drawn to Coast.

In the last three years timber investments in the Pacific northwest have been the heaviest line of investments with the single exception of railroads. It is estimated that \$50,000,000 of eastern and southern capital has come into Oregon and Washington timber lands.
