The Druggists' Association has asked the City Council to amend the anti-trust law so as to exempt the Druggists' Association. We reprint the following from The Oregonian:

They asked that the ordinance be amended to prevent any patent medicine or preparation being sold for a sum less than the price marked on the wrapper. This request was made, they said, for the purpose of PROHIBITING LARGE DEPARTMENT STORES FROM CUTTING PRICES on various articles and drugs far below the wholesale cost merely for advertising purposes. They said that in order to protect themselves against such illegitimate business methods the druggists had to combine to prevent wholesale dealers selling to those who persisted in cutting prices.

One of the members of the Drug Trust said: "We wish you to set a standard price for all articles on which the manufacturers have stamped a price, and that PREVENT THESE CUT-RATE STORES FROM UNDERSELLING US. SEVERAL OF THESE LARGE FIRMS SELL THESE GOODS FOR LESS THAN WE CAN PURCHASE THEM FROM THE MANUFACTURER. Deputy District Attorney Fitzgerald said he believed the ordinance provided that all combinations in restraint of trade should be unlawful. He did not believe, however, that a law could be passed to prohibit an individual from fixing any price on an article, unless he did so as the result of an agreement with others. On the ground that the ordinance prohibited the fixing of a standard price, the petition of the druggists was denied.
