In almost every city, large and small, of the East and Middle West, market men are compelled by law to keep their meats protected from dust and dirt and insects. But why be careful to keep meats clean while being transported through the city, of what use are germ-proof and dust-proof buildings, if the retailer may place those meats where they may gather all the unclean atoms of the downtown district? It won't require a \$5,000 laboratory to discover germs on such meats. Any thoughtful person knows they are there. The baker will protect his pastry from street dust; milk must be covered; butter must be wrapped in paper; the grocer has to hustle to keep his stock clean; but you're never sure of eating clean, healthful meats unless you buy at Smith's.
