WAINWRIGHT TO TAKE FLEET AROUND WORLD.

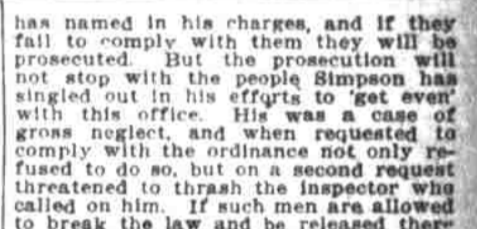

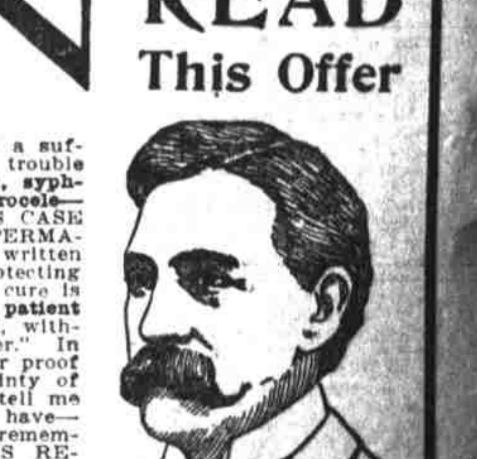
