THOMAS CAR TO SAIL FOR ORIENT

American Auto Expected to Reach San Francisco Today and Go Aboard Ship.

(United Press Leased Wire.) San Francisco, March 24.-Barring accidents the American Thomas car, leading its nearest competitor by many miles in the New York-to-Paris race, will enter San Francisco about noon today and may sail at 1 o'clock in the afternoon for the orient.

San Francisco's prominent automobilists will greet the party at San Jose and accompany it to this city. A. B. Watson of the Automobile Club of California is on the reception committee.
