Former Ambassador to Germany Believed to Have Faked Protest of Kaiser Against David Jayne Hill, Government Investigates.

(United Press Leased Wire.) Washington, March 26.—Diplomatic and administration circles here are astounded this afternoon at the official statement of the German government that no objection has been made in Berlin to the appointment of David Jayne Hill as ambassador to Berlin.

According to belief here, the objection was conveyed to President Roosevelt by Ambassador Charlemagne Tower and the president was given to understand by Tower that the note of objection came from Kaiser Wilhelm's direct.
