Price of Patents Cut—Some Selling Exports at 20c Reduction.

Flour Market 15c Lower.

As has been predicted by The Journal during the past two weeks, the local flour market is quoted at a decline today. The drop amounts to 20c a barrel on patents, and in some instances 20c a barrel on export grades. For several months the flour market has been nominal, owing to the lack of outside business. The market could not be interested in any particular, and this induced some of the sellers to secretly cut their values 20c a barrel in order to work off some of the surplus. Even with this concession in price there has been little business offered to date, although the milling trade expects to come into the market for some fair sized lots in the near future because of the general decline. While some sellers, it is understood, are still holding out for 20c for export grades, practically no business is available for that trade above \$3.50, and from that the price rises down to \$2.50 a barrel. While millers of local flour have not yet published a new card for flour prices, they admit that no sales are being made beyond the former prices. In The Journal for the first time today.

Veal Market Not So High.

A slight mistake was made in quoting veal in this report yesterday. The top of the market at that time was 9 3/4c, and this price is a little far fetched today, for most of the supplies received are sold at 8 1/2 and 9c a pound. There has been a gradual increase in the price of dressed veal along Front street during the past 48 hours. While one receiver who had a "catch" on the market forced buyers to pay 9 1/2c a pound, the general market did not receive that range. This is in justice to those who sold and made returns at a real market price.

Offer Less for Mohair.

Sales of small lots of mohair were reported during the past 24 hours at 20c and 25c a pound, although sellers are not anxious to do business on this basis. The market is showing a disposition to weaken considerably. For this reason some of the former buyers expects the price to drop flat to 20c a pound. However, there is so little mohair offering at this time that the present market can be safely considered nominal in every respect. However, it has a tendency to show which way the wind is blowing.

Still Contracting Hops.

Quite a fair volume of business is shown in hop contracting at the present time. Ties for the coming season's yield are still being made around 15c a pound, but the former values are small generally. There is a small amount of business available in hop goods, but the former values of several months are still continued. The New York Producers' Price Current gives the following view of the situation:

"Locally a little demand is noted from brewers, who are taking advantage of cheap offerings. The exports from this market have attracted some attention as same amount to about 30,000 bales up to date, which is exceptionally heavy. A small amount of business has been exported 3,000 bales of his 1908 holdings. A little more demand has been noted in New York state for both hops and better grades, several dealers having bought a few bales for domestic trade. Prices are unchanged.

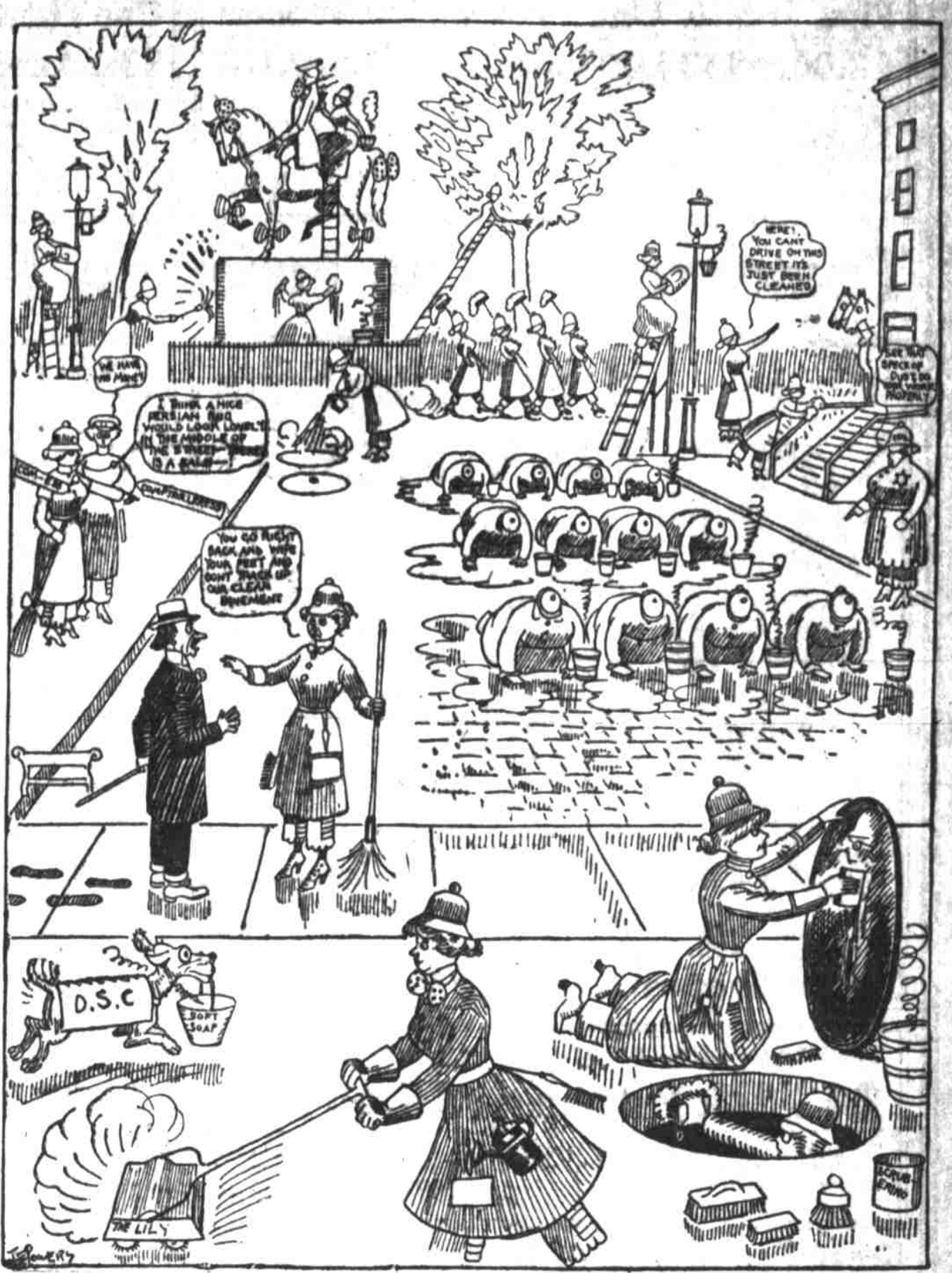

Letters in Divorce Suit Sizable—Husband's Pockets Revealed Secrets.

Domestic warfare in which there is no sign of relenting is being waged in the circuit court by Mrs. Lena J. Eaton against Garrett J. Eaton.
