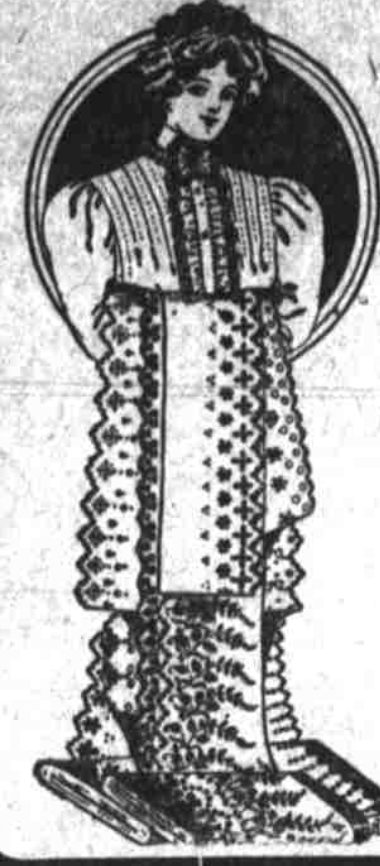

CLEAN GOVERNMENT WINS OVERWHELMING VICTORY

St. Johns Voters Elect Good Government Ticket—City Attorney Candidate Who Figured in Ferry Scandal Exposed by The Journal Is Badly Defeated.

This office the total number of 668 votes was cast, greater than for any other office in yesterday's election, and greater than has ever been cast in St. Johns. Outside of A. M. Esson, candidate for recorder, who had no opposition, H. E. Trench secured the greatest number of votes, despite the fact that he had two opponents.

Overwhelming Victory for Collier.

The total vote cast for Mr. Collier was 399, a plurality of 24, and a majority of 199 of all the votes cast for city attorney. G. L. Perkins was defeated by a vote of practically three to one.

The new officials as elected yesterday are as follows: Mayor, H. W. Brice; recorder, A. M. Esson; treasurer, J. E. Trench; city attorney, Henry E. Collier; councilmen-at-large, S. L. Doble, A. W. Davis and C. L. Johnson of the Taxpayers' ticket; councilmen First ward, J. J. Tryon and W. W. Winkle of the Good Government league; and second ward councilmen, H. W. Bonham and E. C. Hunter of the Taxpayers ticket. These officials take the oath of office and assume their duties Monday, April 14.

Though the Good Government league succeeded in winning a signal victory in St. Johns yesterday by the election of their candidate for mayor, H. W. Brice, and by electing Henry E. Collier city attorney by an overwhelming vote,

The Taxpayers still claim that the victory does not all belong to the Good Government league.

The Taxpayers elected five councilmen out of seven, besides city treasurer, J. E. Trench, who is popular in St. Johns and who is considered quite competent and capable for the position.

The surprising strength of H. E. Collier was the feature of the election. Around the city attorneyship the battle waged strongest, as was predicted. For

was unanimous against annexation in this territory, while it was almost unanimous for annexation in the city. The bond issue appropriating 160,000 for the purchase of city docks was carried. The other bond issue for the purpose of buying a city park was lost by 15 votes.

A peculiar feature of the election is the fact that although 779 voters registered in St. Johns for the election, only 668 votes were cast, more than 100 votes less than the registration.
