MERRY WIDOWS ARE BARRED IN SPOKANE

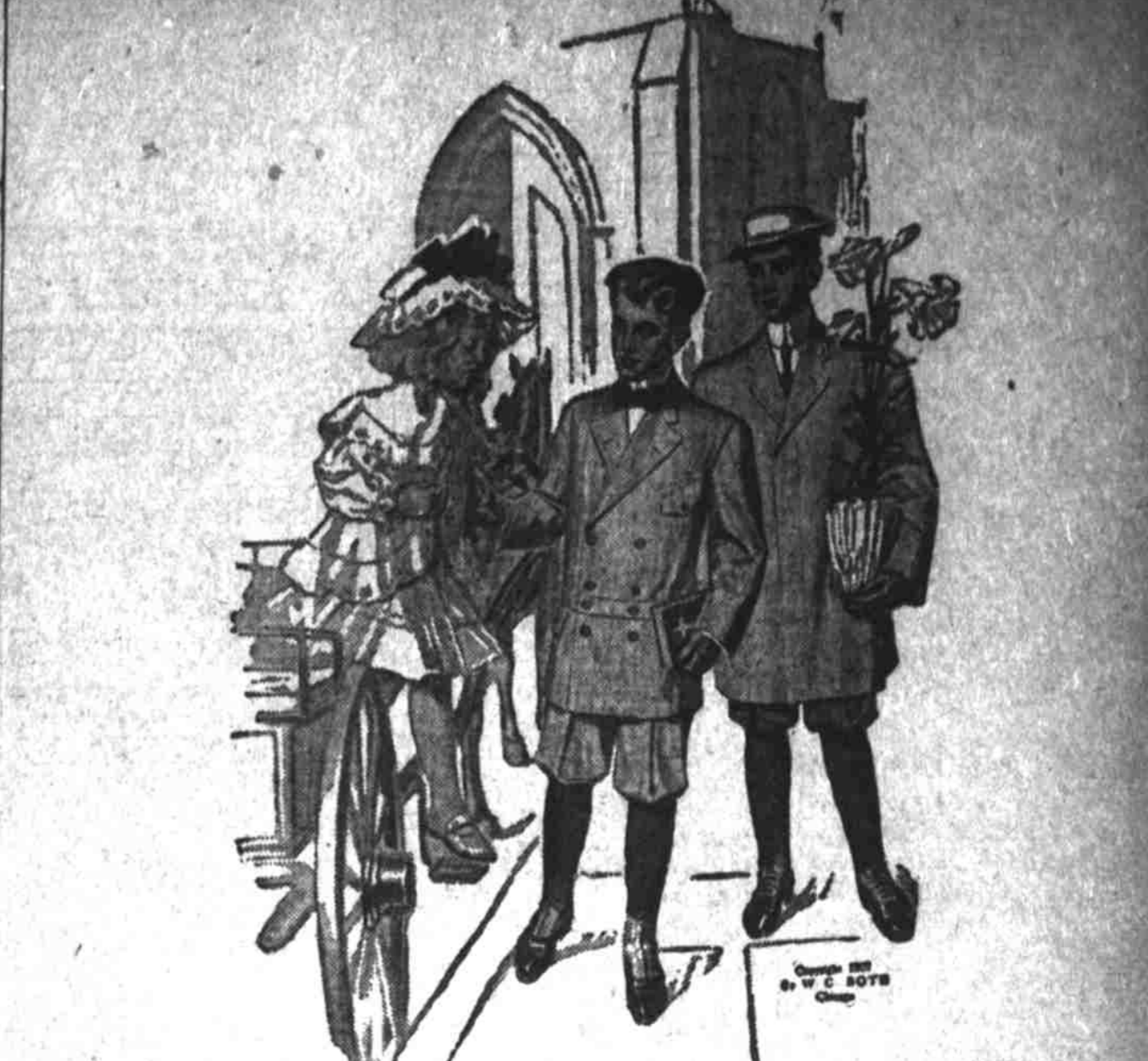

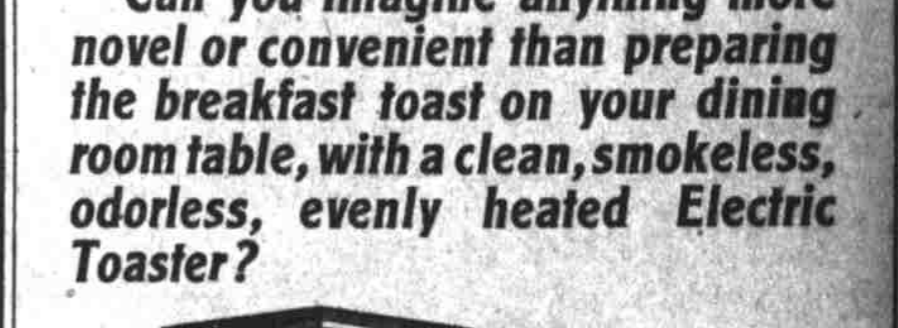
