GROUNDING WAS ABOVE BAY CITY
Bay City, Or., April 14.—To the Editor of The Journal.—In your issue of April 12, on page 13 appears an article headed, "Delayed by Grounding," which is so full of errors and so misleading that I am instructed by the board of trade of this place to publish the following as a correction:
"The Elmore did not strike a bar while on her way to Bay City," nor did she strike on a bar in the channel shortly after entering Tillamook bay."
The facts are these: The Elmore ran aground after leaving Bay City for Tillamook City, and about a mile and a half above the Bay City wharf. She did not ground in the channel, but from 100 to 150 feet out of the channel and on the mud flats as was clearly shown by several members of this board and others who at the time visited the scene of the grounding and made measurements. The Elmore was carrying a part of her cargo by the wharf, near the mouth of the bay. After the grounding the Elmore proceeded on her way to Tillamook City, reaching there about 24 hours after the grounding. It was not until three days after as the article stated.

BOUGHT BANKERS SAYS CROZIER Student of Financial Conditions Sensational Charges.
(United Press Lined Wire.)
Washington, April 17.—Alfred O. Crozier, student of financial conditions and a prominent writer whose home is in Wilmington, Delaware, today made the sensational charge at a meeting of the house committee on banking that members of the currency commission had been "bought" by Wall street to agree to a compromise on the Aldrich financial bill now before the house. The currency commission came to Washington determined to bring about the defeat of the measure. Crozier declares it has suddenly changed its mind in a most peculiar manner. He did not mention the name of the banker who addressed the house committee yesterday, mistaking him for a banker.

In opening his statement Crozier said that it cropped up among his friends that the bankers are dissatisfied with the six per cent tax on emergency currency and that they hold this emergency is wrong in principle and would be dangerous in practice.

"But at 10 o'clock last night our distinguished banking friends held a conference," declared Crozier. "Today they are holding another conference with the wicked promoters of the Aldrich financial bill to agree to a compromise."

"They are now holding out for an amendment reducing the tax to three per cent," it appears to me that Wall street knew its quarry and was familiar with the best way to work it to get support for its measure of that paradise of gamblers."

Crozier then attacked the financial bill, which has already passed the senate, as a law giving all street the power to create a money panic at will and thereby terrorize and plunder, with serious rates as a weapon and wreck prices and the credit of every business industry in the country.

CLATSOP PURCHASES NEW ROCK CRUSHER

(Special Dispatch to The Journal.)
Astoria, Or., April 17.—The county court has purchased a 20-horsepower engine and boiler at a cost of \$370 to operate the new quarry on the Klaskanine. The engine and boiler will be taken to the quarry, near Olney, and the smaller crusher now at that place will be moved to some point further out on the new road being built to the Nehalem valley. Both crushers will be operated during the summer so that as much as possible of the new highway can be covered with rock before the rains of next fall begin. The new crusher has a capacity of 18 tons an hour.
