ACCUSES ROGERS OF SWINDLING

T. Moore Jackson Sues for Million Dollars He Says He Lost.

(United Press Lensed Wire.)
New York, April 24.—Accusing Henry H. Rogers of fraud and false statements, T. Moore Jackson has sued him and George M. Burt and Alfred C. Bedford for \$1,893,939, through Richard J. Donovan. Jackson charges that Rogers deceived him into parting with the control of a small railroad in West Virginia, connecting the B. & O. with the Ohio River railroad owned by Rogers. Jackson, formerly a college professor and mineralogist of note, was one of the first to discover the mineral riches of West Virginia and became possessed of large tracts of mineral and coal lands in the Clarkburg section and up to 1890 he was worth about \$1,500,000. Since then he has lost nearly all of his possessions, as a result, he charges, of fraud practiced upon him by Rogers.
