The most valuable property belonging to the estate consists of lots 23 and 24 in Donohoe's addition, including stocks and warehouses in North Portland. These lots are valued at \$55,000 and the annual income from rent is \$11,000.

Last night the principal feature of the meeting was the address by the general secretary, Marion Lawrence, who spoke on methods of instruction. There was a rally of forces and enthusiasm at the close of the meeting and a resolution was passed recommending that the June 10 Sunday school work this year be raised to \$1,200. Reports from the committees showed progress in the year's work. E. O. Ercell, the well known song writer and compiler, led the song service.
