## TEN STURDY MEN CARRY MESSAGE

Route Laid Out for Portland Association in Relay Race Saturday.

Ten of the fastest men in the big building at Fourth and Yamhill streets will on Saturday strive against the wily redman in an endeavor to beat them from Salem to Portland. The contest is the annual one arranged between the Portland Y. M. C. A. and the Chemawa Indians, with the addition this year of the Salem association. The race will be run by means of relays every five miles.

The race last year was won by the Indians by 19 minutes, though many times on the run the result was a matter of doubt.

This year a troupe of the association men will pace the contestants with wheels, while in addition Physical Director Griley and the judges will follow the men in an auto loaned by the city. Kees's company, the auto will also solve the problem of carrying the men's clothes, thus avoiding the unsatisfactory situation of the year when many men had to turn their lap and then walk back to their starting places to dress.

## GOVERNOR IS STARTER

Physical Director Griley rides over the course today, and will definitely decide on the mile points, where the relays will be made. The start will be made from Salem at 8:30 a. m., and the men will be sent away by Governor Chamberlain handing the first relay a dispatch from the longer distance. This dispatch must be presented by the winner in person to Mayor Lane, who will give the word to start. He has the best course in the race and the only stretch without uphill work. The Y. M. C. A. supporters say he will justify his reputation. Coach Kees will have the distances to Oswego and River view, both having arduous hills. Lau in the distance of about 10 miles. Both men are good pluggers, and this accounts for their selection at this stage of the race.

I expect the winner at the building close on 2:30 o'clock, where Mayor Lane and Secretary Stone will receive him.
