WEATHER REPORT

The storm area overlying British Columbia last evening now appears in the form of a trough over the old Cascade road, which point is southward toward southern Utah. It has decreased in energy and intensity, and the pressure remains abnormally low. Excepting at North Head, Washington, where a maximum velocity of 64 miles per hour was recorded, no violent winds attended this disturbance during the last 24 hours. Moderate rain fell over California, western Oregon and western Washington, but east of the mountains the recorded amounts were inappreciable. Temperatures were lower over the Pacific slope, but were generally higher in the plateau region. A light frost occurred at Roseburg this morning. General rains have fallen over the lake region, middle Atlantic and New England states, plus to disturb and Sunday east of the range. It will probably be cooler tonight in Idaho.
