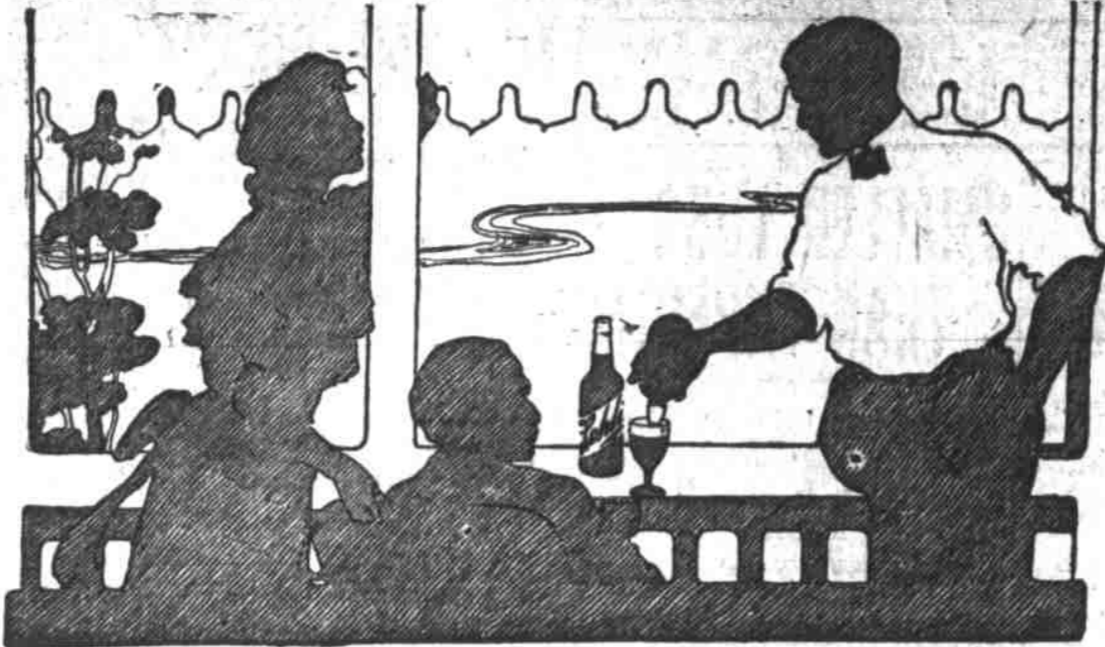
### REALTY MEN INVADE HOOD RIVER ORCHARDS

### EXILE FROM RUSSIA IS CLOWN IN CIRCUS

Nobleman Came to America and Became Remarkably Fine Acrobat.

When the greater Norris & Rowe circus, museum, menagerie, hippodrome and congress of nations exhibits in this city next Monday and Tuesday, a clown will be noticed with a hirsute adornment that rivals the acrobatic piano virtuoso, Paderewski. This clown's name is down on the program as Mickey Feeley—a rather Celtic sounding cognomen. His name in reality is Prince Romanoff Ipwichswich Pertowski—a genuine Russian nobleman, who was accused while attending the University of St. Petersburg, of conspiring against the interests of the "Little Father of all the Russians," Nicholas, the czar, and in order to escape with his neck he emigrated to the "land of the free and the home of the brave," and is taking chances twice a day on the neck that he fled from Russia to protect.

by his fellow performers, has a peppy disposition, but is a good fellow and is well liked. His royal blood sometimes gets to boiling in his blue veins at some imaginary wrongs and straightaway he sends in his resignation, that he might return home and revolutionize the state of affairs in his fatherland. Mr. Rowe takes him in hand on such occasions and persuades him that it is infinitely better to turn double somersaults over a herd of elephants and other hazardous feats in the circus than to return to Russia and work in the salt mines the rest of his life, and the argument generally wins out. The prince, or Mickey, is unquestionably the greatest acrobat in the world. This fellow does the almost incredible feat of turning a double somersault from the bare ground, and his full double twisters and round off doubles are feats that will thrill the most blasé.

Norris & Rowe have over 40 acrobats and clowns with their new big circus, but the prince is the best by long odds. During the engagement of the big circus in San Francisco the Russian consul and some of the most influential Russians in the city were at the circus daily. No doubt they did not like the idea of one of the royal blood of Russia turning somersaults and making funny faces for a living, but they had to acknowledge the prince a success. Norris & Rowe guard Mickey from prospective heiresses, but the prince is a revolutionist, not a man to be purchased for a few dollars and to sit in a hothouse like a toy for some rich woman. ### GET EAST MORRISON READY FOR PARADE

On investigation by the city engineer it has been found that the city is not required to keep East Morrison street between Union avenue and the bridge in repair for four years as has been the general impression, so that the work of improving the roadway by property owners may be begun at once. Most of the taxpayers advocate the building of a hard surface pavement of Belgian blocks and this will in all probability be the material. In order that

the thoroughfare may be in readiness for the automobile parade during the Rose Carnival it will be repaired at once, this having been assured by City Engineer Taylor. Grand avenue from Belmont street to Hawthorne avenue will also be repaired for the "benzene" procession.

Hard surfacing Grand avenue between East Oak and East Stark streets will not be possible until after the fill which is being made with crushed rock has been completed.
