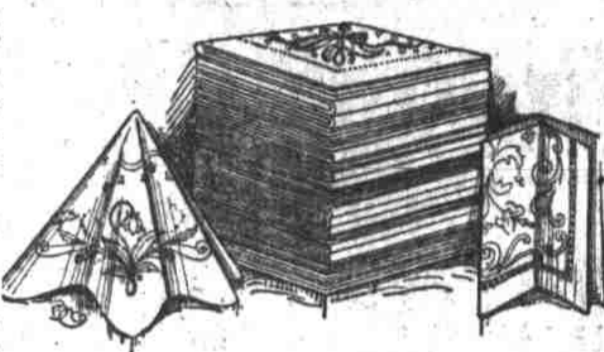

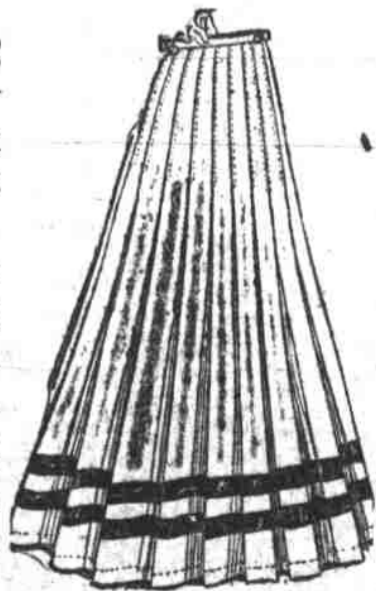

ARTISTS' MODEL BEATS LEAVITT

(United Press Laced Wire.)
 Paris, May 13.—Holmes J. Leavitt, artist and son-in-law of William Jennings Bryan, is slowly recovering from a fearful thrashing administered to him by a model named Conna, who beat Leavitt with a club in the courtyard of the latter's studio. The artist turned

on his assailant with a hammer which he picked up and fractured his skull. Conna is now in a precarious condition. Leavitt has asked for permission to carry a revolver for he fears that the attack by Conna was part of a plot to assassinate him.
 Conna was employed as a model by the artist, but as he could not pose satisfactorily he was discharged. Leavitt says that on several occasions after that he gave the man money, but when he declined to give him any more he was attacked. A few days ago the artist says Conna tried to stab him with a long knife when he was refused financial assistance.
 Washington, May 13.—Mr. Bryan said today that he could hardly believe the story about his son-in-law, for the reason that neither Mrs. Leavitt,

who is living in Lincoln, Nebraska, nor himself have been notified of the affair by Leavitt.
JACK LONDON'S EVOLUTION NOVEL
 Under the Title of "Before Adam" It Tells of Man's Origin From the Monkey.
 London, May 12.—Several novels, which are likely to be interesting, are announced for early publication. One of these is Maurice Hewlett's new book, "The Spanish Jade," which will be issued soon by Cassell.
 The author tells a tale of Spain in 1860; when tourists were comparatively unknown and a traveler, being conspicuous, could be traced from point to point. Hot-blooded Spaniards are thrown into contrast with phlegmatic Englishmen. There will be drawings, with four colored plates depicting Spanish life and scenery.
 Another novel which will claim attention is by Jack London, which Western Lawrie is to publish. It is to be called "Before Adam," the story going back 1,800 centuries in man's history. It tells of days when he was a monkey, gradually evolving to the high-

er level of intelligence.
 Mrs. Thurston means to lay the scene of her next novel in Paris, and she has been there mastering the local color. She says the book will have an unusual central idea, involving more of a psychological question than "John Childe" did. Mrs. Thurston wrote most of her current novel, "The Fly on the Wheel," at her summer home in Ireland. She will write part of her new one in Paris.
 No one has played a greater part in the politics of Russia, especially in presenting them to other countries, than Madame Olga Novikoff. She has been the friend of many leading statesmen of Europe and she is now writing her reminiscences in a book entitled "The Member for Russia." It will contain a large number of letters from notable men, dealing with public questions of

the day as these affect Russia. The book will be published in the autumn. It is likely to create some stir in the political world.
BALLET DANCER.
 Another Accomplishment of English Lady Who Hunted in Rockies.
 From Tit-Bits.
 To her many accomplishments Lady Constance Stewart-Richardson has now added that of ballet dancing.
 Lady Constance has been attending the classes of Mme. Cavalazzi-Mapleson, the famous mistress of the ballet in Covent garden, and wearing the usual costume has been initiated into the mys-

teries of the profession. Lady Constance is said to have a perfect genius for the art, and it she cared to devote the time to it she might become one of the most exquisite exponents of ballet dancing ever seen.
 Unconventional to a degree, Lady Constance is a noted sportswoman. The late champion lady swimmer, a fisherwoman who has landed many a salmon, and an unerring shot, and when in Scotland it amuses her to go out shooting clad in Mackenzie tartan kilt and wearing a tan 'o' shanter.
 Before her marriage in 1904 Lady Constance spent many months shooting in the Rockies, where, she camped alone except for her guides, absolutely out. Dressed in breeches and coat with a cap on her short, dark hair, she looked exactly like a slim, boyish man.
