PARKS SAYS MRS. EDDY IS IN GOOD HEALTH

"Mrs. Eddy is in perfect health. She has not been ill. The report recently published saying she was not in good health is not true," says Edwin J. Parks

in a signed interview in the Boston Globe. "I know her personally, and last week went to see her. She is now 86 years old, but her eye is clear, her voice firm and her step free and sure. I saw her go to her carriage alone, and after a drive of half an hour she returned in fine spirits, when she at once went to her writing room and plunged

into her work. The story originated in the fact that last month for two days Mrs. Eddy did not go riding because it was so cold and stormy that she thought it would be cruel to take the horses out in such weather. On this slender thread of fact some correspondent of the New York papers sent out a wild story totally untrue. Mrs. Eddy is in perfect

health. She will be 87 years old July 16. Personally I have known her nearly a year, and I give my personal word that the story about her being ill is absolutely untrue.
