Judge Webster in the county court has approved the recommendation of William Board as administrator of the

estate of John Magash, approving a settlement with the Northwest Door company, by which firm Magash was employed at the time of his death. Magash was injured while operating a freight elevator early in March. He was thought to be only slightly hurt, but grew worse and failed to survive an operation performed at St. Vincent's hospital. The administrator reported that he is convinced that the company was not to blame for the accident. The estate owes \$225, and the company offered to pay this sum and \$100 additional to be sent to the parents of the deceased in return from a release from all liability.
