ALL WANTED AT MONITOR

ALL WANT TALK FROM GOVERNOR

Every Community in Multnomah County Apparently Demanding One More Address by Popular Candidate for Senator.

Automobile Will Be Used at Close of the Campaign to Rush Chamberlain From One Hall to Another All Over the County.

Indications point to a rousing reception to Governor George E. Chamberlain at the Empire theatre tomorrow evening when he will make one of his concluding campaign addresses. Mayor Lane will preside and there will be a program of music and readings by some of the city's best vocalists and ecclesiastics.

Insistent demands from every town, village and hamlet in Multnomah county that Governor George E. Chamberlain, recognized as the most popular man who has ever held office in the state of Oregon, address the voters before election day swings round, will give the senatorial candidate a much wider field of activity than has fallen to his lot at any time during the present strenuous campaign.

In addition arrangements are being made for the governor to speak at Oriental hall on the fair grounds. Repeated requests have come to his headquarters that his concluding address of the campaign be given in north Portland. If the auto can keep to its schedule and no delays occur, the final address will be made there in accordance with the many wishes expressed. This will make the seventh address of the day.

Arrangements for the big meeting at the Empire theatre tomorrow evening have been practically completed. It is not expected that the building will accommodate half the crowd which will go to hear one of the compelling addresses of the governor's campaign.

Mayor Lane will preside at the meeting. Mrs. Sylvia McGuire will give a reading, and it is expected that Mrs. Walter Reed and some other well known vocalist will appear on the program of music. In addition to Governor Chamberlain's address, the Rev. Dr. J. H. C. Smith, Democratic candidate, will speak briefly.

Sunday is Memorial day, and Governor Chamberlain will observe the day by attending the memorial service at the Soldiers' Home at 10 o'clock.

Three men killed in dynamite explosion.

Seattle, May 27.—Three men have been killed in a dynamite explosion 30 miles from North Bend, Washington. A deputy coroner has gone to investigate. It is supposed the men were working on the right of way of the St. Paul railway.

Plead Limitation Statute.

Washington, May 27.—In the Hayden-Benson land fraud case today Judge Joseph Schneider, one of the defendants, pleaded that their client should be freed on the ground that the statute of limitations runs against the offense alleged to have been committed by him. Arguments in behalf of the other defendants, who are seeking to have the indictment against them quashed, went along technical lines.

\$500 CHALLENGE HAS NEVER BEEN ACCEPTED

If there is a particle of sincerity and good faith in the charge that Governor Chamberlain was guilty of wrongdoing in his administration of the state school lands, why do not the Cakes accept the challenge made by Oswald West? Here is Mr. West's challenge: "I hereby agree to pay to W. M. Calk, chairman of the Republican state central committee, for the use of his brother in his present campaign, five hundred dollars (\$500) if, upon the submission of all the state records having a bearing upon this case, to Mr. John F. Carroll, managing editor of the Evening Telegram, he (Mr. Carroll) does not admit that the course pursued by the governor was wise and commendable, actuated by the purest motives and for the best interests of the state, and that he would have done the same had he been in Chamberlain's shoes."

Six days have elapsed since this challenge was first published in The Journal. It has not been answered or accepted. The failure to accept the challenge is a tacit admission that the charges against Governor Chamberlain are false and that they are made maliciously with full knowledge of their falsity. The daily reiteration of these libellous attacks upon the governor should excite the indignation and contempt of every honest man in Oregon. The people of this state know that George E. Chamberlain is absolutely honest.

BOATS COLLIDE; THIRTEEN DEAD

Fearful Loss of Life Follows Ramming of Schooner by Steamer.

Gloucester, Mass., May 27.—Thirteen sailors of the schooner Fame lost their lives today in a terrific collision between that boat and the steamer Boston of the Dominion-Atlantic line off the Massachusetts coast. The Fame was run down by the steamer with such suddenness that only six of the schooner's crew of 19 were saved. Four of them were put in a dory when the disaster occurred, and John Clark, a sailor, and the steward of the Fame were on board. They were saved by the crew of the Boston, but all efforts to rescue more of the crew failed. It is supposed that the men in the dory have been picked up by some vessel.

THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR SINGLE APPLE

SMUGGLING COST 12 LIVES

Dozen Orientals Who Tried to Enter Country Illegally by Having Themselves Crated and Shipped by Express, Dead on Arrival at New York.

(Special Dispatch to The Journal.) Washington, D. C., May 27.—Twelve Chinese lives was the price paid by daring smugglers to experiment with a new scheme for evasion of the immigration laws. The government has just discovered that a dozen orientals who attempted to gain entrance to this country by having themselves crated and shipped by express from El Paso to New York were dead upon arrival. Acting commissioner of immigration learned today that a gigantic smuggling plot had been unrolled on the Texas border and that Chinese immigrants in the service, is now in New York on the trail of the arch-plotters. Quong Dou Yen received the corpses of his countrymen from the express company and will be arrested if trace of him can be found by the detective. A telegram from Quong Dou Yen to his friends at El Paso revealed the plot. Official interpreter Ping Ming overheard his countrymen at El Paso reading a message which informed them that the twelve men in the crates were dead upon arrival. Ming informed inspectors George Harris and F. W. Berkshire of the plot and they reported it to the bureau here. It is believed that the smugglers crated the men on the Mexican side of the line, hauled them across the river to El Paso, Texas, where they concealed them by express to New York. Secretary Strauss is greatly exercised over the report and has ordered all inspectors to redouble their vigilance and arrest all orientals suspected of being in this country illegally.

BRAVE MEN PRACTICED OPEN WAR

With Absolute Disregard of All Danger Commander Quimby, Lieutenant Tausig and 20 Men Are Shelled at on Monitor Florida.

Men Seriously Jolted by Terrific Impact of Projectiles as Immense Shells Battered Against Heavy Armor Plate.

(United Press Leased Wire.) Thimble Shoal, in Lower Chesapeake Bay, May 27.—(By wireless telegraph to Fortress Monroe.)—Disregarding the danger and apparently anxious to experience open war at sea, Commander John C. Quimby, Lieutenant Tausig and 20 men on the monitor Florida remained on board her today while 12-inch shells were hurled at the great hulk from the great guns of the monitor Arkansas, anchored 300 yards off with her broadside battery in full play on the target ship.

Plans Were Changed. When it was first planned to make the extraordinary test of the power of the guns in warfare, it was not dreamed of keeping any of the men aboard, but the plans for the test were changed suddenly today. Commander Quimby and his men eagerly volunteered to stay aboard their ship while she was submitted to the hammering of the big projectiles. The imminent danger did not lessen their determination in the least.

No Men in Turret. While the men did not take their places in the turret, where it is necessary to manipulate the guns in case of firing, they remained just behind the turret while the firing progressed and they were severely jolted by the terrific impact of the projectiles as they battered against the heavy armor of the Florida.

Steamed Into Position. When the time came for the test, the Florida immediately steamed into her position. The Arkansas and her tender then anchored fore and aft of Thimble Shoal, 300 yards from the Florida, and opened fire upon the target ship. The Arkansas is in charge of Commander Harry M. Denbigh, who with a detail of officers, took up his position on the bridge. The first shot was fired at a screen target raised above the main turret of the Florida and pierced the exact center thereof without a moment's hesitation, giving the men aboard the ship to understand they need not think any of the projectiles would go wild.

Florida Stands Test. Then, according to the program, the Arkansas began firing heavily upon the Florida, immediately piercing the armor against the plates of the Florida, which stood under the bombardment without even showing signs of being crippled. War as a detail of officers, from the use of the glasses the effect was not noticeable, but the experts on the Arkansas reported that the shells were having terrific effect upon the Florida.

Guns Trained on East. After the main bombardment the Arkansas guns were directed against the big Florida and the shells were directed at upon the Florida. It was 125 feet high and on it were two turrets, in which dummies had been placed to show the effect on the fighting tops during an actual engagement. Dummies also had been placed in the main turret of the Florida to show the effect of the impact of heavy shells upon them.

Shows Power of Guns. The "battle" will result in much valuable information which will be used by the experts of the navy in the planning of future men-of-war. It has the double effect of showing the power of American guns when directed against armor plate as it is actually presented in a fleet at sea and the strength of the armor in withstanding the impact of the 12-inch projectiles in warfare.

The experts were entirely satisfied with the experiment. So far as could be learned, none of the daring men on board the Florida sustained any injury, as the shells did not tear their way through the turret.

DISBARMENT PROCEEDINGS

Man Who Is Said to Have Been Instrumental in Publishing Land Office Yarn About the Governor Works "Both Ends."

A. W. Lafferty, a Portland attorney having offices in the Fenton building, who has made a specialty since coming to the city of practice before the United States land office, has been made the defendant in disbarment proceedings brought by direction of United States Land Commissioner Bennett of Washington, D. C. As a result of Lafferty's acts before the land department the commissioner has preferred charges of irregularities which if established will prevent him from practicing before the department in the future. The charges were filed with the local land office subsequent to an investigation into Lafferty's methods of doing business made by special agents employed by the land department.

DEAD ENGINEER HELD THROTTLE

Overland Flyer Bound for Frisco Had Miraculous Escape From Wreck.

(United Press Leased Wire.) Chicago, May 27.—That the overland flyer of the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul, bound for San Francisco, was not wrecked and hundreds of passengers killed and injured through the death of the throttle of the aged engineer, Albert Cavil, is due to the discovery of the dead man as the train was bounding over a crossing.

The death of Cavil, who had been employed by the company for 25 years, was not known until the fireman was startled when the train flew by dangerous interlocking switches and across a maze of tracks at Byron, Illinois, paying no attention to signals. He stepped forward and found the engineer dead in the cab, death having been caused by a hemorrhage of the brain.

WASPS OF WAR HERE

Torpedo Fleet and Cruiser Yorktown Will Be in Portland Harbor During the Rose Festival Next Week.

Line of March for Great Parade Wednesday Morning Decided Upon by Committee—Procession Nearly Seven Miles Long.

Three torpedo-boats, the Fox, Davis and Farragut, and two torpedo-boat destroyers, the Preble and Perry, left San Francisco yesterday afternoon for this port. Under ordinary conditions they should reach the river Thursday morning and be in Portland harbor that day. The gunboat Yorktown started north last night.

Of the three torpedo-boats two, the Fox and Davis, are strictly Portland products, having been built here in 1896-99 by the Wolf & Zwicker iron and machine works, which also constructed the torpedo-boat destroyer, Goldsborough with disastrous financial result to the firm.

The Fox and Davis are of exactly the same dimensions, being 145 feet in length, of 15 feet inches beam, and having a mean draft of five feet ten inches. They have a speed of 23 knots. The Preble and Perry are of the same type, having been built here in 1896-99 by the Wolf & Zwicker iron and machine works, which also constructed the torpedo-boat destroyer, Goldsborough with disastrous financial result to the firm.

The torpedo-boat Farragut, which is in the bunch now coming north, can outrun anything in the navy excepting the T. A. M. Craven, another torpedo-boat of the same type, which she has her own. They have a respective speed record of 30 knots an hour. The Farragut was built at the Union Iron Works of San Francisco.

The Perry and Preble come under the head of torpedo-boat destroyers, being larger than the average torpedo-boat. Their respective speed record is about 26 knots per hour, half a knot less than that of the above mentioned torpedo-boat Farragut.

A dispatch was received this morning at Astoria, Oregon, from the Pilots' association from Captain Gleason of the United States cruiser Yorktown, asking for a pilot, as the cruiser will be off the coast Friday, May 29, and asking for a pilot to take him up the river.

Parade Seven Miles Long. This morning the festival committee on the automobile parade completed its arrangements for the line of march. The parade will be held Wednesday morning. It will be 136 blocks long—5.5 miles—and will pass the reviewing stand on the Pennsylvania block twice. It will take, it is estimated, an hour and a quarter for the parade to pass a given spot.
