"THE THUNDERBOLT" Milder Than Title

London, June 3.—The new Finero play at the St. James' theatre, "The Thunderbolt," is less lurid than its title suggests. It concerns the not very thrilling doings of a provincial English family, the Mortimores, of Single-hampton, but it is constructed in Finero's masterly manner. The Mortimores are middle-class peo-

ple—James is a builder, Stephen owns a local paper and Thaddeus (George Alexander's part) is a musician. Their sister has married a colonel, lives in London and is "in society."

There was an elder brother, Ned, who had made a fortune as a brewer, and he died just before the play opens. The family have gathered for a death-bed reconciliation with Ned, who had been estranged from his brothers and sister for years. James and Stephen hold rigid temperance views. The dead man's fortune is estimated at about \$1,000,000, but to the surprise of the surviving Mortimores, no will can be found.

In the discussion it is mentioned that a natural daughter of Ned Mortimore's, Helen Thornhill, is expected, and Mrs. Phyllis Mortimore, Thaddeus' wife, says they ought to see her well provided for out of her father's estate. When Helen

arrives, however, she refuses to take any money, for she is ambitious to make her living as an artist.

The search for Ned Mortimore's will is fruitless and the daughter goes to stay with "Tada" (Thaddeus and his wife) and Phyllis has grown to love the girl. James and Stephen have started speculating on their share of their brother's fortune and have embarked on costly business schemes, while Colonel Fording, their brother-in-law, has taken a bigger house in London.

Then comes the "thunderbolt." On the eve of a family council, Phyllis confesses to her husband that she found a will leaving everything to Helen and destroyed it. She did not know then that Helen Thornhill was Ned's daughter, but imagined she was only "some woman."

Thaddeus determines to tell the truth

about the will at the family council, but rather than let his wife be punished for felony he takes the blame on his own shoulders. There is a great scene of passion and recrimination in which, however, it becomes evident that Thaddeus is not the guilty party, but that he is shielding his wife.

When Helen Thornhill learns about the destroyed will, she is pleased to know that her father did not forget her, but she will not have the will proved because it will involve the prosecution of her friend, Phyllis, for the crime of destroying a will. Eventually it is arranged that Ned Mortimore's money shall be divided equally between Helen and the Mortimores.

The sort of June days furnished Portland so far are rare, or ought to be.

Wants Police Chief Fined.
Munich, June 3.—The editor of Die Kritik has been fined for publishing an illegal advertisement. He paid the fine and then demanded that the state's attorney file an indictment against the chief of police for the same offense. It appears the chief who was instrumental in bringing about the editor's prosecution, ran the identical advertisement for which Die Kritik was punished in the book of addresses published by the police department.

Alcohol Decimates Paris.
Paris, June 3.—After devoting two years of study to the question of death due to alcohol, directly or indirectly, Dr. Perret of the French Academy of Medicine announces that 25 per cent of all

deaths in Paris coming under the surveillance of the medical and hospital authorities are due to the misuse of alcohol.

Kamtschatka to Be Explored.
St. Petersburg, June 3.—Twenty men of science—historians, geographers, astronomers, surveyors, ethnographers, doctors of natural history and medical men—are bound for Vladivostok, there to be equipped with military means of transportation and a guard for the expedition of Kamtschatka.

Has Slimmest Waist.
Paris, June 3.—Mlle. Polaire, the actress, has the slimmest waist in France for a woman of her height and weight—namely, 43 centimeters (16½ inches).

King's Son in French Army.
Algiers, June 2.—The One Hundred and Twenty-sixth regiment of the 1st Division has a real royal prince. Coming service as a sub-lieutenant—His Highness Prince Montev, 20 years of age, and fat, has hardly any excuse for a nose, and eyes as round as a comedy. But he is intelligent and kindly and loves army life.

Professor Designs.
San Jose, Cal., June 3.—It has been announced that the trustees of the University of the Pacific have accepted the resignation of Dr. W. C. Sawyer, head of the German department and formerly acting president of the institution. His health caused the doctor's resignation.
