BIG BOAT RACE FOR RIVER LAUNCHES

Enormous Crowds Visit the Warships at Anchor in the Harbor.

MORE PEOPLE THAN BOATS CAN CARRY

Perfect Order is Maintained Along Waterfront and No Serious Accidents Have So Far Marred the Festivities.

It is estimated that fully 5,000 people visited the warships in the harbor yesterday afternoon. At last and for once the launch owners are having all the business they can handle and there is very little of the keen howling competition that in former years marked the presence of a few warships in the harbor. Everything is moving along in an orderly manner.

Hundreds of small craft have been pressed into service and a dozen large power boats with capacity for from 50 to 100 are in commission carrying sightseers from the docks to the ships at anchor. At first the cruiser Charleston received almost undivided attention. Many of the sightseers yesterday, the gunboat Yorktown and the torpedo boats were black with the surging crowds. It is said, however, that yesterday afternoon a small boat last night when no one was injured, no accident has so far marred the great activity along the waterfront. Some of the boats have been overcrowded and there have been no collisions of serious nature. Perfect order has been maintained at the Starbuck dock where most of the boats land, and dock owners along the front have assisted the police in maintaining order. The trip to the boats has been very orderly and there have been much more order than under similar circumstances in the past.
