

# LOOK FOR COVE TO GIVE SHELTER

## Master Mariners Discuss Advantages of Having Place Selected.

### SAY CAPE BLANCO COULD BE IMPROVED

#### Under Existing Conditions Craft Are Compelled to Battle With Storms When It Would Be Desirable to Run for Cover.

Mariners plying along the coast are discussing the advisability of starting a movement with the purpose in view of establishing a suitable place between San Francisco and the Columbia river where vessels might put in for shelter if partly disabled or when backing up against a heavy storm and sea.

At present the coast line is quite unfamiliar to a number of mariners because of the danger of striking rocks and reefs when running in close, and therefore even smaller craft are compelled to keep out to sea in storms when they would save fuel and perhaps time if they could dodge into a sheltered bay and anchor while waiting for the storm to blow over.

Shelter Cove along the California coast has been found a desirable place for small coasters, but it, too, is said to be dangerous because of rocks, and masters will not take it to except under most extraordinary conditions. A few days ago a number of lumber droghers bound north sought shelter there while a terrific northwester howled along off shore and poured up tremendous combers.

It is said in the lee of Cape Blanco would be found a suitable anchoring ground if a few rocks barring the entrance were blasted away. Possibly the government can be induced to have this done and mariners have talked the matter over until it is probable that it will be laid before the authorities in the near future.

#### EXPECT TIDE TO ASSIST.

Attempt Will Be Made to Float Minnie Kelton Today.

An attempt will be made this morning to float the wrigged steam schooner Minnie E. Kelton which has been lying in Youngs bay, near Astoria since towed into port by the steam schooner Washington after having been abandoned off Yaquina bay several weeks ago.

The attempt will be made at high tide and barges will be placed alongside upon which it is intended to rest the vessel while towing her up to the drydock at St. Johns where repairs will be made. The hull is filled with lumber and therefore exceptionally heavy.

Since towed in the wreck has steadily cooled and there is some question of its being possible to float it. Several attempts to pump out the hold proved failures.

The Kelton was abandoned after the deckload and house had been carried away in a storm in the vicinity of the mouth of the Columbia river when the vessel was bound from Grays Harbor to San Francisco. Eleven of the crew were drowned.

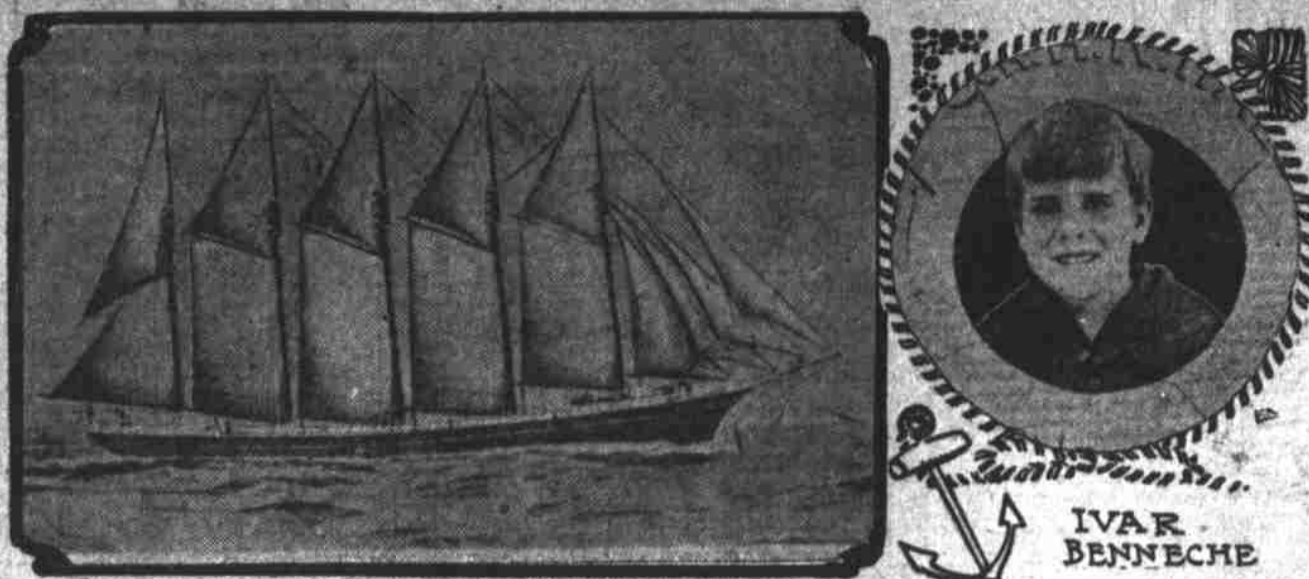

## IN FACE OF ENEMY.

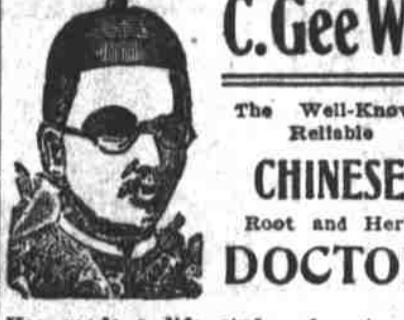
Uncontrollable Desire in Situations of Great Tension.

It is not an uncommon thing for a soldier to fall asleep even when ostensibly taking an active part in an action. A case in point is supplied by an interesting communication from a London surgeon who served in South Africa. He writes:

Any one who has seen men in situations of great tension knows that some of them—in fact a small minority of them—may be overcome by an uncontrollable desire to sleep. It affects some men more than others. An interesting case is recorded in the writer's experience when Colonel Bullock (now General) Bullock was in command of a Boer force double his own in numbers, better armed and assisted by artillery. He was surrounded by the Boers, and the Boers failed to take the post.

During the attack the writer visited a trench in which one man was badly hit and another was lying apparently dead, except that he had not the color of a man killed in action. The writer turned him over to get a better look at him and found the man had been sound asleep.
