FLORIDA HOLDS SECOND PRIMARY
Election Held Today to Settle Contests Caused by First Election.

(United Press Special Wire.)
Jacksonville, Fla., June 16.—A second legislative primary is in progress throughout Florida today to decide the

contests left over from the indecisive first primary of several weeks ago, in which no candidate secured a majority, as is necessary under the Florida laws. Public interest centers chiefly in the race for United States senator to fill the seat of the late Senator Mallory. Governor Bryan himself died soon after the death of Senator Mallory. Governor Brown appointed William J. Bryan, a prominent young lawyer of Jacksonville, to fill the vacancy. Senator Bryan himself died soon after assuming the office and Governor Brown or Brown then named W. E. Miller to fill the vacancy, and soon after towards announced his own candidacy in the state primary. Opposing him were D. W. Fletcher, a successful lawyer of this city, W. B. Lamar, representative in congress from the Third district, and State Senator John S. Beard of Pensacola.

FORESTERS RESIST INCREASED RATES
(United Press Special Wire.)
Toronto, Ont., June 16.—The supreme court of the Independent Order of Foresters, the most important fraternal and benevolent organization in the Do-

minion, with a membership of nearly 385,000 in Canada and the United States, convened in this city today with the prospect of an exceedingly lively session before it. The proposed revision of the insurance rates is to come up for consideration and action and it is already evident that the proposal will meet with vigorous opposition.

The proposal which is to be acted upon is not merely to increase the assessments from now on, but is retroactive. If carried out, the old members who joined the order prior to 1899 will be required to pay the difference between their present assessments and the assessment rates which it is proposed to establish from the date of their identification with the organization, if they wish to keep up their insurance.

This plan is put forward despite the fact that on January 1 of this year the treasurer's statement showed that there was a surplus of nearly \$12,000,000.

The order, which is nearly 30 years

old, is essentially a "poor man's" insurance company. The rates are low, and the officers have always sought to impress upon the public the advantages to the poor man. Thousands of those who have been paying assessments for from 10 to 25 years are too poor to pay the back assessments with the 4 per cent interest, which it is proposed to require, or, in fact, to pay the increased assessments from now on. Moreover, many of them are too old to ask for insurance in other companies. These members, through their representatives at the present meeting, are preparing a vigorous protest to prevent, if possible, the adoption of the new plan.
