By Hyman H. Cohen. Those who are disposed to think, despite all utterances to the contrary, that the fruit crop in the northwest, and Oregon in particular, are going to be heavy this season, should take a look at the weather and their inquiries will turn their thoughts in a different direction.

As a whole the Pacific northwest is not going to produce a heavy fruit crop this season. This applies solely to the marketable quality, for there is no doubt that the quantity of stuff that will not come up to the demands of the market and shippers would be far better off were they to keep the grower's stuff at home. In many instances it will scarcely pay the express charges, close the cost of the package and putting it therein.

Weather conditions have been against a bumper fruit crop not alone in the state, but in Idaho and Washington. Some crops, such as cherries, were greatly damaged and will scarcely come within sight of early expectations and estimates.

Down in southern Oregon where weather conditions are somewhat better with progressive methods utilized by growers they are not going to give the world nearly so large a quantity of fruit as has been reported. Latest advices from the Medford country—the heart of the Cornice section—indicate that they will not have more than possibly 75 cars to tickle the palates of the easterners at 140 a box and 100 a bushel.

There have been many stories regarding Oregon strawberries that took two bites to consume, but the ones shown in the picture were larger than those and three bites would be scarcely more than sufficient to make each one disappear.
