

CAVE BLOWS NERVE AWAY

Natural Wonder in Idaho Is a Cavern Through Which Fearsome Winds Roar So That None Dares Attempt Explore It.

Nampa, Idaho, June 20.—On the ridge bordering the south side of the Deer Flat reservoir, not far from Snake river, a cave has been brought to the attention of the newer generation of settlers that had been one of the points of special interest in the early history of this section. E. P. Shaw, auditor for the Idaho Northern railroad, in the office of E. H. Dewey, has taken a homestead in the neighborhood of the cave and a number of parties have gone out to his ranch at which they organize for exploration.

On account of the strong wind that comes whirling out of the cavernous depths of the earth at that particular place, the cave has been known as the "Cave of the Winds" and only a few of the most daring have ventured into the place. From these it has been learned that there is actually a great underground cavern that extends farther than any dared to go, and the wind that blows out from the depths gives rise to a peculiar trepidation, such that those who have thus far attempted the investigation have speedily retreated.

River Connection Indicated.
In describing the cave they claim that it seems to extend on a very moderate incline toward the southwest, toward Snake river. Occasionally it is precipitous for a few feet, and then leads away again for hundreds of feet on a gentle declivity.

On account of the wind, those who have been down to any considerable depth have found it difficult to keep a lantern burning, and they have not ventured further than 500 feet. A well that was put down by a nearby homesteader has the peculiar draft of air coming out of the pipe that was driven down into the lava. In other sections of this country, when water has been obtained in the lava it has universally been very hard and of a peculiar alkaline nature, but the water obtained from the well near the big cave is particularly soft and much the same as the Snake river water.

This condition has led to the theory that there is an underground current, not unlike a river, that carries with it a current of air which on reaching these openings escapes to the surface.

Wind Blows All the Time.

The wind is strong enough to produce a roaring sound at all times in the well, and more particularly so in the cave. The nature of the lava strata underlying Deer Flat with these peculiar features in the immediate vicinity, have led many people to predict that the food of waters coming into the big federal reclamation reservoir will drop into some such cavern and that it will be impossible to fill the reservoir as anticipated. To guard against any such contingency it is said the reclamation surveyors will be provided with means to build cement caps over any such openings as might ever appear.

The opening of the "Cave of the Winds" is only a short distance from the reservoir line and it is certain that if the water were to find its way to that opening it could pour away in a veritable river.

NO MORE BETS IN NEW YORK

Bingham Declares Court Action Will Not Deter Police from Making Arrests.

New York, June 20.—Police Commissioner Bingham announced this afternoon that none of the court action yet taken would deter the police from stopping betting at the race tracks until he receives a decision from the city corporation counsel. Governor Hughes instructed Acting District Attorney Elder, of Kings county, to file a writ of habeas corpus directing the sheriff of Kings county to produce Melville Collins, who was arrested at Sheepshead yesterday on the charge of making bets. Argument on the writ will be heard Monday and it is now announced that this proceeding will be made the basis for the main test of the new law. In the meantime Collins is paroled in the custody of his counsel.

Police Commissioner Bingham this afternoon ordered all the inspectors in charge of the various divisions of the police, to see that every pool room in the greater city is closed immediately. It is a notorious fact that hundreds of poolrooms have been conducted constantly and that heretofore the police have been unable to stop them. Bingham says that the war is now on and that he will enforce the new law to the letter.

ASHLAND'S FOURTH IS TO BE GLORIOUS

Ashland, Or., June 20.—Ashland is preparing to celebrate the nation's birthday in a way that will surpass all other celebrations ever held in this part of the state.
