PERFORATED STAMP SALE IS DELAYED

Although the new cycling of the post-office department allowing firms to mark stamps by perforation has been in effect

for some time none of the Portland stores or companies has as yet taken advantage of the regulation.
The perforation of stamps is for the purpose of preventing the taking of the stickers from the offices by any of the employees and to assist in identifying letters should they be lost.
For several years department stores and other firms who use the mails to a great extent have endeavored to have some system adopted, whereby they

could identify letters. May 1 an order went into effect in the postoffice department approving of the perforation plan suggested. The mark must not mar the face of the stamp and must not occupy more than one third of an inch square.
The order is known as No. 1291, and is an amendment of section 862, paragraph 4, of the postal laws and regulations. It reads:
"United States postage stamps to be accepted for postage must be absolutely without defacement; provided, that for

the purpose of identification only, and not for advertising, it shall be permissible to puncture or perforate letters, numerals or other marks or devices in United States postage and special delivery stamps. The puncture or perforations shall not exceed one sixteenth of an inch in diameter, and the whole space occupied by the identifying device shall not exceed one third inch square. The puncturing or perforating must be done in such manner as to leave the stamp easily recognizable as genuine and not previously used. The

use of ink or other coloring matter in connection with such puncturing or perforating is prohibited."
The advantage of this new device is obvious, as it will enable business houses to protect themselves against loss of mail by registering their perforation marks with the postoffice department for reference.
Postmaster Mintz expects that before a great while the Portland firms will take advantage of the new ruling allowing the perforation.

Illinois Police Chiefs.

Elgin, Ill., June 23.—The eighth annual convention of the Illinois Policemen's association assembled here today and was called to order by President D. Frank Gahan of this city. A two days' program of papers and discussions has been prepared. Two matters in which the association is particularly interested are the extension of the civil service in police departments and a pension system for policemen.

Scout Cruiser's Trial Trip.

Boston, Mass., June 23.—Much interest is manifested in naval circles in the preliminary trial today of the new scout cruiser Salem. The trial takes place over the Rockland course. The contract calls for a speed of 34 knots. Her builders, the Fore River Shipbuilding company of Quincy, and the naval experts who have superintended her construction are confident that the cruiser will meet all requirements.
